



Making your own horn for the unicorn is an easy process! You can probably make this from your existing stash in about 15 minutes. Plus you can choose fabric to coordinate perfectly to your unicorn. These directions create a 5" horn that is meant to be a companion to Gingercake's Magical Unicorn Sewing Pattern.



- 1. Begin by gathering materials (pictured and labeled above) and printing out the pattern piece on page 6. Cut 1 triangle from the pattern in the fabric of your choice. Cotton fabric is best because it is easiest to sew onto the unicorn but others are ok with some patience and extra effort.
- 2. Fold the triangle in half to make a right triangle, right sides together. Sandwich the floss in between with the tip of the floss coming out the top edge. See the photo below.





- 3. Sew down the angle, using a 1/4" seam allowance, securing the floss to the top edge. Make sure to backstitch.
- 4. Turn the piece right side out. Poke out the top with a chop stick or similar tool.
- 5. Stuff with polyester fiber fill.





6. Use a needle and thread to sew a gathering stitch around the base. Pull gently to gather. Once it is gathered tightly, tie a knot so the gather is secure. Then push raw edges inside horn with finger or end of chopstick.





7. Finally, wrap floss around horn to create the swirl. With the needle and thread, secure end of floss in place under the horn with knots. Cut off extra floss. Finished!
